An initiative of HEDC, the Harnett County Jobs Campaign goal is to create 1,000 new jobs by the end of 2030. A goal accomplished through job announcements at or above 125% of the County's average wage, from new and expanding companies and private sector development and investment.

OPPORTUNITY 1

Each day, **62% of Harnett County's labor force commutes outside the County** for work. The Jobs Campaign aims to create 1,000 new above average wage jobs throughout the County, keeping more talent in our community.

OPPORTUNITY 2

Harnett County has a **high demand for industrial and flex buildings**, ranging from 12,000 SF to 30,000 SF., but supply is limited. The Jobs Campaign aims to bring ready industrial sites and buildings to the market across the County and within all five municipalities.

PLAN OF ACTION

Working closely with local stakeholders, site development funding partners, and allies such as the North Carolina Department of Commerce, EDA, USDA, and the Golden LEAF Foundation, HEDC will **focus efforts on product development activities that spur private sector investment**.

Golden LEAF Funding Drives Progress at Edgerton Industrial Park

In June 2024, HEDC was awarded \$547,885 from the Golden LEAF Foundation's SITE Program - Development to support the creation of a market-ready industrial site at Edgerton Industrial Park (U.S. 301 & Gateway Drive, Dunn, NC). Site 1 is currently being cleared and graded, with completion expected in Q4 2025. Site 2 is scheduled for completion in Q2 2026.
